### **For Podium Paper Submissions**

- Abstract should be no more than 300 words, excluding titleand authors/advisor
- Please organize with the following sections:

Title: Keep the title brief, but indicate the nature of the study or service

Authors: Include all authors and denote who will present the paper, if accepted

Project Purpose: Include a brief description of the problem being addressed

Methods: Research methods or interventions in the case of an educational or service project

Results: Specific outcomes achieved, whether a research, educational, or service project

Conclusions: Relate these to results and consider the next steps to be taken in your work

### **For Posters Submissions**

- Abstract should be **no more than 300 words**, excluding title and authors/advisor
- Please organize with the following sections:

Title: Keep the title brief, but indicate the nature of the study or service

Authors: Include all authors and denote who will present the paper, if accepted

Project Purpose: Include a brief description of the problem being addressed

Methods: Research methods or interventions in the case of an educational or service project

Results: Specific outcomes achieved, whether a research, educational, or service project

Conclusions: Relate these to results and consider the next steps to be taken in your work
